RESOLUTION FOR DUES INCREASE**

The following resolution was presented to the craft at the Stated Comunication on March 7th and approved to be held over for vote at the Stated Communication on Thursday, April 4th.

To the officers and members of Roe Fulkerson Masonic Lodge No. 299.

WHEREAS, the finance committee of Roe Fulkerson Lodge No. 299, has determined that due to increasing operating expenses, the current dues of \$108.00 per annum is not sufficient to cover those expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the dues be increased from \$108.00 to \$133.00 per annum and the By-Laws of Roe Fulkerson Lodge No. 299 be revised, to read as follows:

4.01 Dues.-Every member of this Lodge shall pay to the Secretary, for the use of the Lodge, the sum of \$133 per annum plus the Grand Lodge Per-Capita Assessment, which sum shall be due and payable in advance on or before the first day of each Masonic Year, which Masonic Year shall begin on the 28th day of December of each year and end on the 27th day of December of the following year, except life members, honorary members and those members whose dues are remitted in accordance with Masonic Law.
